

THE SHOW MUST GO ON

The 2023 Atlanta Film Festival marked a massive resurgence in in-person events. With more than double the crowds in 2022, last year's festival was the closest to pre-COVID attendance. Also, with the pivot to virtual in 2020, the festival reached more viewers not just outside of Georgia but the US, with content streamed in 41 states and 27 countries. Additionally, ATLFF'23 not only included big audiences but big names as well! Recent festivities included special guests Keke Palmer (Nope & Hustlers), George R.R. Martin (Game of Thrones & Night of the Cooters), Vincent D'Onofrio (DareDevil, Jurassic World, & Law & Order: Criminal Intent), and Rainn Wilson (The Office). Building on this momentum, ATLFF'24 is ready to raise the bar once again.

IN-PERSON SCREENINGS


The Plaza Theatre's indoor safety protocols are industry leading. In addition to standard measures, it also includes:
